Subject: San Francisco Vice President Runoff Election

On December 1, the California Elections Company (CEC) and the Election Committee conducted the vote count for the unionwide Executive Committee Officer Elections. Results were sent to the membership and are posted on the [Local 21 website](#). According to the Local 21 bylaws, in the event that no candidate receives a majority of the votes, the Election Committee will conduct a runoff election. The San Francisco Vice President race [requires a runoff election](#) between the top two vote getters, Danielle J. Harris and Rinaldi Wibowo.

* Rinaldi Wibowo	133	27.4%
Jo Elias Jackson	125	25.8%

Election Guidelines and eligibility rules remain the same as those in place during the primary election. Ballots will be mailed to all eligible members on December 19. Ballots must be received at the election P.O. Box in San Francisco by no later than 5:00 p.m., January 9, 2018, to be counted. California Elections Company (CEC) and the Election Committee will conduct the vote count on January 10, 2018.
