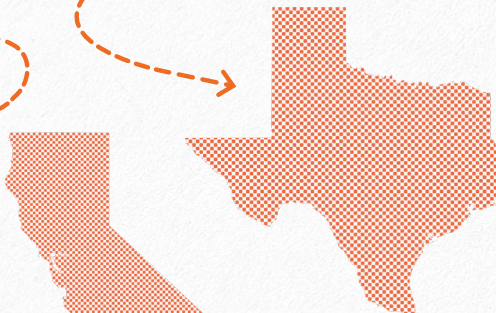
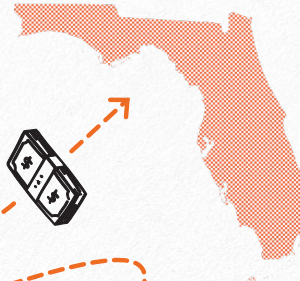
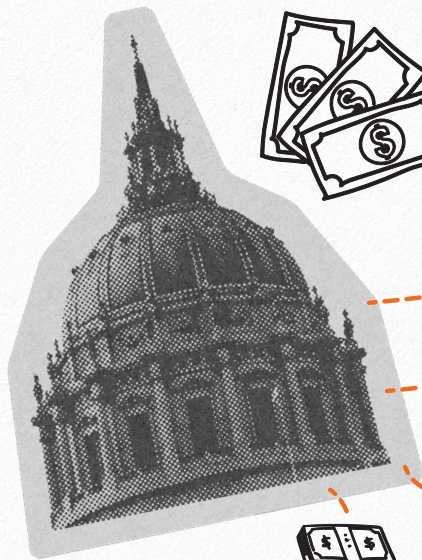
How Private Contractors Inappropriately Manage City Services
